Call for abstracts and pre-registration

The Hydrology Days 2017 will take place at the Earth Sciences Centre, Gothenburg University on March 16 & 17. We suggest "Urban Hydrology" as the main topic but other water related contributions are also welcome. The Hydrology Days are arranged annually by the Swedish Hydrological Council SHR, this year supported by the Department of Earth Sciences, University of Gothenburg, IAH (International Association of Hydrogeologists) Sweden and SGF (Swedish geotechnical society).

The Hydrology Days are a meeting place for Ph.D. students, early-career scientists, senior researchers, end users and agencies. The meeting provides the opportunity for Ph.D. students and Postdocs to present their research who are especially encouraged to contribute to the meeting's scientific agenda.

Please note that we can support 10 Ph.D. students (and young postdocs) with up to 1000 kr for travel and accommodation. To obtain this support, Ph.D. students have to:

- Pre-register for the conference (see below). Support will be provided for the first 10 Ph.D. students to submit the pre-registration.
- Participate in the conference and present a paper (poster or oral).
